Perio Diagnosis Script:

(1) Many patients become upset with 2 facts about a good dental office:

- a. Patient was not able to get a cleaning done during their examination appointment.
 - -Patient must schedule a second appointment to receive their cleaning.
 - -Patient feels they wasted their time doing x-rays and exam but then were unable to receive cleaning.
- b. Patient must pay extra for perio codes to receive their cleaning
 - -Perio codes are for patients that present with gum disease (periodontal disease)
 - -The perio codes include the following options for cleanings:

Full mouth debridement, D4346 Scaling inflamed mouth, Perio maintenance, Scaling Root planning

(2) <u>In-direct Consequences of Periodontal Disease:</u>

- -Periodontal disease contributes to cardiovascular diseases such as artherosclerosis.
- -Periodontal disease contributes to diabetes mellitus.
- -Periodontal disease has adverse effects on pregnancy outcomes.
- -Periodontal disease contributes to **osteoporosis**.
- -Periodontal disease may be linked to **Alzheimer's disease**.

(3) Extra Cost of Perio Codes:

- -Many patients complain that their previous dentist gave them prophylaxis cleaning which is usually fully covered by insurance and therefore free to the patient
 - -This means their previous dentist simply failed to treat their gum disease.
 - -Our dental office cares enough about your cardiovascular system and brain to give you the perio codes your periodontal disease requires.
 - -We want to help you delay the strokes, heart attacks, dementia conditions such as Alzheimer's disease and other systemic conditions that await the periodontal disease patient.

(4) We have observed periodontal disease in your examination:

- a. Your x-rays show horizontal bone loss, causing exposure of your roots.
- b. Your x-rays show **sub-gingival calculus deposits** (calculus spurs).
- c. Clinical exam of your teeth has produced one or more of the following findings:
 - Calculus bridges (large calculus deposits on the teeth)
 - -Red or purple gums around your teeth (showing inflamed gingiva)
 - -Normal gums are pink in color, which is characteristic of healthy gums
 - -Blooding on probing (blood exudes from your gums when probed with a perio probe)
 - -Probing depths of 4mm or greater around your teeth.
 - -Healthy gums have probing depths of 0.5mm to 3mm
 - -Dental floss is able to properly clean and maintain a 3mm gingival pocket.
 - -Un-healthy gums have probing depths of 4mm to 12mm
 - -Dental floss is not able to clean and maintain gingival pockets of 4mm or more
 - -Fetid odor of gum disease emanating from your gums
 - -Visible gum recession causing root exposure.

(5) **Dont shoot the messenger.**

- -We are just here to let you know that you have gum disease; and try to help you fix it.
- -We are required by regulation to inform you of the gum disease you exhibit.
- -We are REQUIRED to treat you properly with perio codes to treat your gum disease.
- -It would be completely inappropriate for us to give you prophylaxis cleaning when we have identified the signs of gum disease in your examination.
- -If your previous dentist was giving you prophylaxis cleanings because its fully covered by insurance then they were not doing you any favors.
- -Would you rather have free cleanings now or protection from strokes and Alzheimer's disease when you are elderly?
